Tried to call you a couple of times however, I gather you've been on holiday for the past fortnight and you are obviously busy catching up.

I writer concerning the letter received from Jim Hyslop, Scottish Executive dated 4<sup>th</sup> October which was addressed to our Group. I'm sure you'll have a copy of this. I wish to state from the outset that CVDG are most keen to move on from what might be termed past differences – perceived or otherwise. I would like to think that we could meet with a clean sheet and a common purpose.

As you know, CVDG wish to develop Carron Forest as a MTB centre and the ambition has never been anything other than to do so in full partnership with FCS. Much has changed over the last 2 years - not least some of the questions hanging over Carron Valley. We feel these have been largely answered and most importantly of all the current trails have proved to be an undoubted success with the public. With this in mind, CVDG spent the last few months surveying and developing an outline Project Plan for building a network of MTB trails and a significant length of multi user trail including path work to Meikle Bin and the Loup of Fintry.

This project was funded by North Lanarkshire Council and has since been fully endorsed by Central Scotland Forest Trust (they are prepared to provide staff and resources to fundraise and Project Manage – all subject to FCS approval of course) Stirling and North Lanarkshire Councils. The CSFT offer is obviously a major development, it represents a massive leg up for the project.
