I understand you wish to discuss the best way forward for construction contracts for the future mountain bike trails. As the CVDG's expert in the field of construction contracts and in particular those associated with Civil Engineering works I am more than delighted to meet up and discuss future contracts and project planning.

My background is that I am a Chartered Civil Engineer with more than 20 years experience and currently am the for I am also a Planning Supervisor for the Council although that role will soon change to Planning Co-ordinator following the recent changes in Health and Safety CDM Legislation. For the trail construction projects to date I held the Planning Supervisor role for CVDG.

The contract that was let for all the construction to date was an ICE (Institution of Civil Engineers 5th Edition) with Civil Engineering Standard Method of Measurement third edition (CESMM 3) applying. The specification was put together to contractually bind the winning contractor to deliver a quality product. Along with these documents went a Health and Safety Plan (to be developed by the Contractor on appointment) and Instructions for tendering.
